## Nondisclosure Agreement

This Nondisclosure Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between \_\_\_\_\_ ("Disclosing Party") and Antalogic LLC, Belarus, Gomel, Lenin Avenue, 10, off. 902, +375 (29) 102-82-87 ("Receiving Party") for the purpose of preventing the unauthorized disclosure of certain proprietary and confidential information ("Confidential Information") as defined below.

1. **Definition of Confidential Information.** For purposes of this Agreement, "Confidential Information" shall include all information or material that has or could have commercial value or other utility in the business in which the Disclosing Party is engaged.

2. **Exclusions from Confidential Information.** The Receiving Party's obligations under this Agreement do not extend to information that is: (a) publicly known at the time of disclosure or subsequently becomes publicly known through no fault of the Receiving Party; (b) discovered or created by the Receiving Party before disclosure by the Disclosing Party; (c) learned by the Receiving Party through legitimate means other than from the Disclosing Party or Disclosing Party's representatives; or (d) is disclosed by the Receiving Party with the Disclosing Party's prior written approval.

3. **Obligations of Receiving Party.** The Receiving Party shall hold and maintain the Confidential Information in strictest confidence for the sole and exclusive benefit of the Disclosing Party. The Receiving Party shall not, without prior written approval of the Disclosing Party, use for the Receiving Party's own benefit, publish, copy, or otherwise disclose to others, or permit the use by others for their benefit or to the detriment of the Disclosing Party, any Confidential Information. The Receiving Party shall return to the Disclosing Party any and all records, notes, and other written, printed, or tangible materials in its possession pertaining to Confidential Information immediately if the Disclosing Party requests it in writing.

4. **Time Periods.** The Receiving Party's duty to hold Confidential Information in confidence shall remain in effect until the Confidential Information no longer qualifies as such - within the meaning of clause 1. above - or until the Disclosing Party sends to the Receiving Party written notice releasing the Receiving Party from this Agreement, whichever occurs first.

5. **Law and Jurisdiction.** Any conflict or dispute under this Agreement shall be subject to Belorussian law and the jurisdiction of the Belorussian Courts.
